



Erasmus Policy Statement (EPS)

Belgrade Metropolitan University is a small, but modern university aiming to provide quality higher education that satisfies needs of employers and ambitions of its students, by implementing modern teaching methodologies supported by ICT-based teaching technologies. Tempus and Erasmus + programs have helped us to develop multidisciplinary programs, such as Computer Games (IT and digital arts), short-cycle and part-time programs, and dual education. We want to continue with this policy that will maximize effects of implementation of project results, by implementing the following criteria and principles for selecting Erasmus+ projects in the future:

- We are looking primarily for partners from EU interested in joint education and/or research projects, and an exchange of students and staff
- We will promote and implement European Student Card (ESC)
- Our collaboration will be based on principles of equality, process transparency, and inclusion of different minority groups.
- Special attention will be directed to promotion and implementation of ecological practice
- Implementation of Quality Assurance Strategy of BMU in all our international collaboration activities, as well as principles and priorities of European Education.

Belgrade Metropolitan University supports European modernization and internationalization agenda in higher education. It embraced the Bologna Process from the very beginning, as well as the project of the European Research Area, actively partaking in the modernization of higher education across Europe, while also cultivating ties with universities in the region and other parts of the world.

Participating in the Erasmus Programme has been an integral part of Belgrade Metropolitan University's Internationalization Strategy and this Erasmus Policy Statement is based on it.

Belgrade Metropolitan University has Centre for international cooperation responsible for coordinating international cooperation and providing administrative support for higher education and research activities and projects.

Belgrade Metropolitan University expects from its students and staff to act as active citizens in our environment and in society in order to contribute to development of Serbia, as a democratic and prosperous European country, based on European values, in order to become member of EU as soon as possible.
